The South Australian Accelerated Literacy Program aims to build local school capacity through developing quality teachers with a deep knowledge of theory and practice that makes a difference for students. The following professional pathway has been developed to support schools in this goal.

<p>Introduction to Accelerated Literacy (4 days) Registration is online, and link is posted on SAALP website in Week 1, Term 1.</p>	\$260 per head (refreshers from the previous year and 1 leadership position free)	<p>Introduction to the Accelerated Literacy pedagogy, explicit teaching sequence and underlying theories. Prerequisite for any teacher who will be supported by a consultant.</p>
<p>South Australian Accreditation in Accelerated Literacy SAALP calls for Expressions of Interest in Term 4 each year.</p>	No cost	<p>For teachers who have completed Introduction to AL and whose take-up of pedagogy is identified as being of a high standard. Accreditation is required for any recognised AL school leadership position. This course is at post-graduate standard and may be recognised for advanced standing for further university study.</p>
<p>SAALP Enriching AL practice Equivalent to LIC502 in the Graduate Certificate in Accelerated Literacy previously offered through Charles Darwin University. Bronwyn.parkin@sa.gov.au Offered across 2013, with intensive on 15th and 16th April.</p>	No cost	<p>For accredited AL teachers who wish to continue their learning at post-graduate level. This subject may be recognised for advanced standing for further university study, but teachers need to negotiate this direct with the university. Completion of this course and the final subject in 2014 do not need to complete re-accreditation.</p>
